

PURE LOOP celebrates premiere of new ISEC evo

The new ISEC evo from PURE LOOP is being presented at this year's K trade fair. Visitors to the show can expect an extensive redesign of the processor model plus intelligent process engineering enhancements. ISEC evo means up to 25 per cent more throughput, lower repelletising costs and easier use.

Düsseldorf, 20 October – PURE LOOP presents the new ISEC evo at the K show in Hall 9, B 17. Compared to its predecessor model, the Austrian company's proven shredder-extruder technology offers both technical and user-oriented optimisations. LLDPE stretch film is being recycled live during the show on an ISEC evo 202. A camera system inside the cutting unit allows attendees to follow the recycling process in real time via a monitor on the PURE LOOP trade fair stand. "The demand for high-quality recyclates from production scraps is increasing rapidly. These developments prompted us to make the ISEC evo even more user-friendly and of course more economically efficient," explains PURE LOOP CEO Manfred Dobeberger. The highlights of the new developments are without doubt the up to 25 per cent increased throughput, the automatic start/stop of the system at the press of a button and a turnable hood which offers greater flexibility in terms of setup.

Within the EREMA Group, PURE LOOP stands for the highly efficient recycling of clean production waste using shredder-extruder technology.
